1. March 28 and April 9: The TFT Advisory Committee met at HS Principal Shirley Lundberg's office to discuss student recruitment and fundraising (Gina Foglia, Shirley, David Meshoulam, Libby). Susan Falkoff has resigned from the Advisory Committee.

2. April 4: Michele Waldman and Libby met with Brian Costello of Watertown Housing Authority at 100 Warren Street to talk about adding trees on the barren Warren Street frontage (faces North). Possibly some apple trees. Consulting Judy Fallows.

April 6: Genie Johnston, David Jay and Libby met at Town Hall with Blair Hines, Verdant Landscape Architecture, landscape architect for 385-392 Pleasant St, to look over landscaping plans together. Discussed irrigation, species survivability and long term planning in the face of speciesspecific blights and climate change. TFW made some recommendations for species adjustments.
